

#### 4 GIFTS THAT WEAKNESS BRINGS


### **1. THE GIFT OF PAUSING TO LOOK IN THE MIRROR**

'I am deeply convinced that the Christian leader of the future is called to be completely irrelevant and to stand in this world with nothing to offer but his or her own vulnerable self.'




