STAGE 1 IDENTIFY

BASIC PRINCIPLES

- 'Everyone can develop leaders through affirmation and encouragement'. You don't have to be a leader to develop others. Affirmation (literally=to support) and encouragement (literally=to give strength to) really do make a difference. It's as simple as that.
- 'For the sake of many invest in a few'. Of course, Christian leaders should play a part in creating a general atmosphere of encouragement. But they also need to identify and invest in particular individuals as Jesus did. This may prove controversial, but it is strategically important.
