



PAUL PERKIN

Jonah

Paul Perkin both studied and taught physics, having specialised in theoretical physics at Oxford University where he discovered a living faith in Christ. After ordination he served in the dockyard town of Gillingham in North Kent, and then at Holy Trinity Brompton, where he was also Chaplain to the Brompton Hospital.

In 1987, Paul and his wife Christine led the planting of a new congregation at St Mark's Battersea Rise, which has grown from 50 to 600 adults and 150 children. During this period they have in turn planted twice: a group of 65 adults to restart the ministry of the Church of the Ascension Balham Hill, and more recently to take responsibility for a new injection into two neighbouring parishes, St Peter's and St Paul Battersea, on one of the toughest housing estates in London.



Paul's work includes teaching, leading the staff team and developing the community ministries at St Mark's. In his spare time Paul enjoys motorbikes, hiking, skiing and gardening.

JONAH 4In the Shade – Jonah Quarrelling

'He's everything we hoped for, but nothing we expected.'	KEY INSIGHTS
Verse 9: 'God said to Jonah, "Do you have a right to be angry about the plant?" "It is", he said, "And I'm so angry I wish I were dead".'
