## **ABOUT THE SKYDIVE**

Fly through the clouds from 10,000 feet for an unforgettable experience by taking part in a charity tandem Skydive where you will get to see spectacular views whilst strapped to a fully qualified instructor.

#### **Start Time**

07:45 on Saturday 21 June 2025.

Please arrive promptly so that our group will be on the first plane rides.

#### Location

Hinton Airfield Steane Bracklev NN13 5NS

Please be aware of the speed limits going through the village. There are also a number of speed cameras and we don't want our guests to have their days ruined by being caught out.

**ESTIMATED FINISH TIME:** The morning skydives will finish by 13:00 However, this is weather dependent, as rain, excessive cloud cover and or high winds could cause delays so please avoid any bookings in the afternoon until after 17:00. In such circumstances, the centre tries to wait it out, but on rare occasions they have cancelled the day and asked guests to rebook there and then at no additional cost.

**JUMP HEIGHT:** You will jump at 13,000ft which is 2.4 miles high.

## **Itinerary**

7.45 Arrival

Registration 8-8:30

9-9.30 Training in the hangar

Plane rides begin (one plane every 40 minutes), skydivers wait for their call. 9.30

**SPECTATORS:** You are welcome to bring as many people you wish. There is no limit. Friends and family can wait outside with you and will have full sight of the landing zone.

PHOTOS/VIDEOS: There is the option to have your jump filmed. The cost to have a video/still photos is £130 per person, payable on the day. The cost to have landing photos is £35 per person, payable on the day.

**ADDITIONAL INSURANCE:** Safety is absolutely paramount at the centre. There is the option of purchasing additional insurance should you wish. This can be arranged on the day.

**CLOTHING:** We recommend warm and comfortable clothes whilst you wait. You will be given an overall on the day along with a hat and goggles.

For guests who are waiting, please be prepared for both warm and cold weather. We highly recommend sunglasses as you will be staring at the sky for prolonged periods.

**REFRESHMENTS:** There is an on-site cafe where you can purchase hot and cold drinks, as well as snacks. Card payments are accepted. As the waiting period is unpredictable, we recommend that each participant bring a bag with drinks, snacks and forms of entertainment to pass the time.

**PARKING:** There is plenty of free parking outside the centre.

**TOILET:** There are toilets on site.
